Series of 2024

“AN ORDINANCE DECLARING NEW TABO DAYS IN THE CITY OF SURIGAO AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ORDINANCE NO. 463 SERIES OF 2022, AND ORDINANCE NO. 337 SERIES OF 2012, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

The Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Surigao hereby **ORDAINS**:

Section 1. *Section 1 of Ordinance No. 337, Series of 2012 and Ordinance No. 463 Series of 2022, are hereby amended to now read as follows:*

TABO DAYS. To provide and serve the essential needs of the people of Surigao and to promote livelihood income generating measures to the people of the barangays, there shall be a “Tabo” in Surigao City to be held in the following places and on the specific schedule allowed, to wit:

1.a. For **Brgy. San Juan** – Whole day of every Tuesday and until 12:00 noon of Wednesday to be situated on the following specific location.

- 1st Road (Macario Diaz Street up to corner of portion of Rafael Eliot Street).
- 2nd Road (Diaz corner P. Quinto St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner N. Eguna St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner R. Kaimo St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner F. Monteros St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner R. Eliot St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner P. Coleto St. (4 meters both side),
- Diaz corner Silvosa St. (4 meters both side)
- Diaz corner V. Gonzales St. (4 meters both side)

1.b. For **Brgy. Washington** – Whole day of every Friday and until 12:00 of Saturday to be situated on the following specific location.

- Corner of Camia and Pio Castro Streets up to Bagong Silang

Section 2. *Section 2 Of Ordinance No. 337, Series of 2012 is hereby amended to now read as follows:*

The “Tabo” schedule shall begin not earlier than 4:00 o’clock in the morning and shall continue until 12:00 noon the next day, on the days mentioned in Section 1 hereof. No person shall display or cause to be displayed, anything for sale before the designated time. Anything displayed before the designated time shall be deemed a nuisance and shall be confiscated summarily.

Only agricultural, marine products, handicrafts, used clothing and foodstuffs shall be displayed for sale in the “Tabo”.

Section 3. *Section 3 of Ordinance No. 337, Series of 2012, is hereby amended to now read as follows:*

DEPUTIZATION – The Barangay Officials of Brgy. San Juan and Brgy. Washington are hereby deputized in enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance and are wholly responsible in the supervision of the conduct of the tabo activities, including the collection of prescribed fees, the traffic flow and the collection of garbage and other kinds of dirt in the designated tabo sites.

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2(a) AND 15, OF ORDINANCE NO. 228 SERIES OF 2005 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

The Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Surigao hereby **ORDAINS:**

Section 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

Section 2(a) is amended to read as follows:

- a. **Tricycle for Hire** refers to a motor vehicle composed of:

Conventional Type:

- Motorcycle fitted with a single wheel side car,
 - Motorcycle with two (2) wheeled cab
- (Taken from LTO Memorandum Circular No. 94-199)

Non-conventional Type:

- Three (3) wheeled vehicle (“Bao-bao” or “tuktuk”);
 - Quadracycle (Bao-bao or Tuktuk)
- (Taken from LTO Memorandum Circular No. 2020-227)

392 **Section 2.** Section 15 is amended by adding another sub-section thereof and will read as
393 follows:

395 Section 15.g. There is hereby granted a separate route exclusively for the “bao-
396 bao” for hire tricycle operations in order that said operations will not be in competition with the
397 conventional and existing type of tricycle for hire, to wit:

399 15.g.1. **Brgy. Sukailang** (to include Anomar, Trinidad, Quezon, and Bonifacio) to
400 the designated terminal in the *poblacion* and vice versa;

401
402 15.g.2. **Brgy. Mapawa** (to include Brgy. Silop) to the designated terminal in the
403 *poblacion* and vice versa;

404
405 15.g.3. **Brgy. Danao** (to include Ipil and Mabua) to the designated terminal in
406 the *poblacion* and vice versa;

407
408 15.g.4. **Portion of Brgy. Luna Tuazon Village** (Exit Terminal), NEA Cortes
409 (Pangpang Riverside), Bacud to the designated terminal in the *poblacion* and vice versa;

410
411 **Section 3. EFFECTIVITY.** This amendatory Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
412 its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Surigao.
