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184 **HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:**

185 *Good afternoon to my colleagues. The first committee report is that of the Committee on*
 186 *Urban Development and Land Use.*

187 **SUBJECT OF THE REPORT:** *Proposed Deed Of Donation to be executed by Don Julio Ouano*
 188 *Resources Association Incorporated (DOJURAI) as well as the City Government of Surigao City.*

189 **FACTS:** *Don Julio Ouano Resources Association Incorporated (DOJURAI), is an organization*
 190 *registered to the Security and Exchange Commission. It own Lot No. 796-A-2-B covered by TCT No.*
 191 *T-11866 which is said to be road lot.*

192 *DOJURAI decided to donate the parcel of land to the government so that the building of*
 193 *houses by informal settlers on the road lot can be prevented. Further the so that it can be improved*
 194 *by the City Government.*

195 *During the committee hearing, it was found out that the Owner's Duplicate of Transfer*
 196 *Certificate of Title No. T-11866 in the name of Don Julio Ouano Resources Association Incorporated*
 197 *has been lost and the officers of DOJURAI made the commitment that they would facilitate the*
 198 *issuance of a new Owner's Duplicate.*

199 *However, under the law, an Owner's Duplicate of a Certificate of Title can only be issued*
 200 *only by order to the proper court, and so, it is necessary for DOJURAI to file the corresponding*
 201 *petition with the court for the issuance of a new Owner's Duplicate of TCT No. T- 11866.*

202 *Further, the Resolution supposedly authorizing the President of DOJURAI to make the*
 203 *donation has been made subject to ratification by the general membership of DOJURAI and there is*
 204 *no showing that there was a general assembly where the resolution was duly ratified.*

205 **RECOMMENDATION:** *The Committee on Urban Development and Land Use would like to*
 206 *recommend that:*

207 *1. DOJURAI should first initiate the filing of a petition in court for the issuance of a new*
 208 *Owner's Duplicate of TCT No. T-11866.*

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210 *2. Another resolution be passed by the officers of the Board of Director of DOJURAI*
 211 *authorizing the President to make the donation without the necessity of calling for*
 212 *general assembly for the ratification of the same resolution.*

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214 *May I move for the adoption of the committee report, Mr. Chairman?*
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217 *The motion to adopt the committee report was approved. Thereafter, a motion was*
 218 *presented indorsing back the matter to the Office of the City Mayor, the City Planning and*

219 Development Office and to the Assessor's Office to take note of the recommendations and to act on
 220 the recommendations which was favorably seconded and approved, to wit:

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RESOLUTION NO. 123 – 2024

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A RESOLUTION ENDORSING BACK THE PROPOSED DEED OF DONATION TO BE EXECUTED BY DON JULIO OUANO RESOURCES ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED (DOJURAI) AS WELL AS THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SURIGAO CITY, TO THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, CITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE AND THE CITY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE, TO ACT ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE.

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WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an indorsement from the City Mayor, requesting the City Council to authorize him to enter into a Deed of Donation between the Local Government Unit of Surigao City and Don Julio Quano Resources Association Incorporated (DOJURAI) the entirety of the road lot (Lot No. 796-A-2-B) covered by TCT No. T-11866 situated at Barangay Canlanipa, Surigao City represented by its President Pio L. Sembrano;

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WHEREAS, Don Julio Quano Resources Association Incorporated (DOJURAI) is an organization registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission;

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WHEREAS, DOJURAI owns Lot No. 796-A-2-B covered by Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. T-11866, designated as a road lot;

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WHEREAS, DOJURAI has decided to donate the said parcel of land to the City Government of Surigao City to prevent the building of houses by informal settlers on the road lot;

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WHEREAS, during the committee hearing, it was found that the Owner's Duplicate of TCT No. T-11866 in the name of DOJURAI has been lost, and the officers of DOJURAI have committed to facilitating the issuance of a new Owner's Duplicate;

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WHEREAS, under the law, an Owner's Duplicate of a Certificate of Title can only be issued by order of the proper court, necessitating DOJURAI to file the corresponding petition with the court for the issuance of a new Owner's Duplicate of TCT No. T-11866;

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WHEREAS, the resolution supposedly authorizing the President of DOJURAI to make the donation has been made subject to ratification by the general membership of DOJURAI, and there is no showing that there was a general assembly where the resolution was duly ratified;

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WHEREAS, the Committee on Urban Development and Land Use has recommended the following:

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1. *DOJURAI should first file a petition in court for the issuance of a new Owner's Duplicate of TCT No. T-11866.*

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2. *Another resolution be passed by the officers of the Board of Directors of DOJURAI authorizing the President to make the donation without the necessity of calling for a general assembly for the ratification of the same resolution.*

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NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Jose Expeditus B. Bayana, seconded by Honorable Joseph Joey S. Yuipco, it was unanimously

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RESOLVED: To pass a resolution endorsing back the proposed Deed of Donation to be executed by Don Julio Quano Resources Association Incorporated (DOJURAI) as well as the City Government of Surigao City, to the Office of the City Mayor, City Planning and Development Office and the City Assessor's Office, to act on the recommendations of the Committee.

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RESOLVED FURTHER: That copies of this resolution be furnished the Honorable City Mayor, City Planning City Planning and Development Office, and the City Assessor’s Office, for their information.

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Honorable Bayana continued.

HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:

Yes, another one, Mr. Chairman. Again, from Committee on Urban Development and Land Use.

Subject of the Report: The Intention of Mr. Samuel B. Ancla to Execute a Deed of Donation in Favor of the City for an Area Covering One Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Five Square Meters (1,135 sqm) to be Used as a Road Right of Way at Barangay Anomar.

Facts: The Deed of Donation is to be executed by a certain Samuel B. Ancla. It is said based on the documents he is a co-owner of a parcel of land denominated as Lot No. 8730 cut 234 located a Barangay Anomar, Surigao City, and covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. 162-2021614.

The original owners or the names appearing in the Transfer Certificate of Title are the heirs of Vicente B. Ancla, Jr., and therefore, the heirs of the deceased are considered co-owners of the same.

While the heirs executed an extrajudicial settlement among them which contemplated among others, that the parcel of land a portion of which will be donated to the City by Mr. Samuel B. Ancla. Unfortunately, in the extrajudicial settlement among the heirs of Vicente Ancla, Jr., it is only stated that the properties of the deceased are to be divided equally among themselves. In other words, there is no showing which portion of the parcel of land will be owned by a certain co-owner including Mr. Samuel B. Ancla.

In the absence, therefore, of an approved survey plan, as well as, as reflected in the corresponding extrajudicial settlement of estate showing that the portion to be donated is to be adjudicated to Samuel B. Ancla, he cannot, on his own, donate a specific portion of the property.

Recommendation: It is recommended by the Committee that another extrajudicial partition of estate be executed whereby the portion to be donated to the City will be specifically adjudicated to Samuel B. Ancla before he can donate a portion thereof to the City Government.

May I move for the adoption of the committee report, Mr. Chairman.

The motion to adopt the committee report was approved. Thereafter, a motion was presented that resolution be passed indorsing the matter back to the Office of the City Mayor, the City Planning and Development Office, the City Assessor Office so that the recommendation of the committee can be acted upon which was favorably seconded and approved, to wit:

RESOLUTION NO. 124 – 2024

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING BACK THE INTENTION OF MR. SAMUEL B. ANCLA TO EXECUTE A DEED OF DONATION IN FAVOR OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SURIGAO FOR AN AREA COVERING ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE SQUARE METERS (1,135 SQM) TO BE USED AS A ROAD RIGHT OF WAY AT BARANGAY ANOMAR, TO THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, CITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

332 **OFFICE, AND THE CITY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE TO ACT ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF**
 333 **THE COMMITTEE.**

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335 **WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an indorsement from the City
 336 Mayor, requesting the City Council for authority for him to accept the Deed of Donation with Mr.
 337 Samuel B. Ancla of a parcel of land consisting of 1,135 square meters to be used as a Road Right
 338 of Way in Barangay Anomar;

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340 **WHEREAS**, the original owners of the said parcel of land, denominated as Lot No. 8730 cut
 341 234, are the heirs of Vicente B. Ancla, Jr., who executed an extrajudicial settlement among
 342 themselves stating that the properties are to be divided equally among the co-owners, but it did not
 343 clearly specify the portion of the property to be owned by each co-owner, including Mr. Samuel B.
 344 Ancla;

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346 **WHEREAS**, in the absence of an approved survey plan and clear adjudication of the portion
 347 to be donated to Samuel B. Ancla, he cannot proceed with the donation to the City Government;

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349 **WHEREAS**, the Committee on Urban Development and Land Use recommends that another
 350 extrajudicial partition of the estate be executed, whereby the portion to be donated to the City
 351 Government of Surigao is specifically adjudicated to Samuel B. Ancla before he donates it to the City
 352 Government;

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354 **NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Jose Expeditus B. Bayana, seconded by
 355 Honorable Karl Duane A. Casurra, it was unanimously

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357 **RESOLVED:** To pass a resolution endorsing back the intention of Mr. Samuel B. Ancla to
 358 execute a Deed of Donation in favor of the City Government of Surigao for an area covering One
 359 Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Five Square Meters (1,135 sqm) to be used as a road right of way at
 360 Barangay Anomar, to the Office of the City Mayor, City Planning and Development Office, and the
 361 City Assessor's Office to act on the recommendations of the Committee.

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363 **RESOLVED FURTHER:** That copies of this resolution be furnished the Honorable City
 364 Mayor, City Planning City Planning and Development Office, and the City Assessor's Office, for their
 365 information.

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Honorable Bayana continued.

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372 **HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:**

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Again, by the Committee on Urban Development and Land Use.

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*There is Letter Request of a Certain Josephine A. Luna and Jocelyn A. Quitlig Supposedly
 Representing the Heirs of Spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular for the Passage of a
 Resolution Signifying the Sangguniang Panlungsod Lack of Objection to a Deed of Revocation of
 Donation Dated March 13, 2024.*

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Facts: *Per Deed of Revocation of Donation duly notarized by Atty. Sean Clark Labastida,
 the late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular executed the first donation in favor of the City
 of Surigao with the condition that it shall be used as a site of Tagbangkaan Primary School of the
 provincial capital of Surigao, Province of Surigao del Norte. This was recorded, again per deed of
 donation, revocation of donation in the notarial register of the late Atty. Pedro C. Navarro sometime
 in the year 1955.*

388 *Also in the same year, the same late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular executed*
 389 *another Deed of Donation where they conveyed to the then Municipality of Surigao, represented by*
 390 *then Mayor Ramon Kaimo, one hectare of land, known as Lot No. 2560 situated at Barangay Oroc,*
 391 *Surigao City, and covered by Original Certificate of Title No. RO-232. The second donation was*
 392 *subject to the condition that it will be used as a school site.*

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394 *According to the Deed of Revocation of Donation, the portion subject of the first donation*
 395 *until now remains unutilized while the Oroc Elementary School now stands on the land which is the*
 396 *subject of the second donation.*

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398 *In the Deed of Revocation of the Donation, the heirs of the donors would like to revoked the*
 399 *first donation and demanded that the City of Surigao immediately reconvey the ownership and*
 400 *possession of the same to the heirs.*

401

402 *Firstly, revocations of Deed of Donations are governed by the New Civil Code.*
 403 *Unfortunately, the indorsement from the Office of the City Mayor did not attach the two Deed of*
 404 *Donations. Consequently, there is no way to confirm that both donations were subjected to conditions*
 405 *that the lots covered by the same will be used as school sites. In fact, it cannot be determined if the*
 406 *donation is absolute in nature, was absolute in nature or subject to conditions, or subjected to*
 407 *conditions. Moreover, there is also no proof as to what is the relation of Josephine A. Luna and*
 408 *Josephine A. Quitlig to the donors to the late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular.*
 409 *Therefore, it cannot be verified whether or not the two who executed the Deed of Revocation of*
 410 *Donation are heirs of the donors or that they are the only heirs of the donors.*

411

412 ***Recommendation:*** *It is, therefore, given the lack of documents it is recommended that the*
 413 *Sangguniang Panlungsod in the meantime refrain at the moment from passing a resolution*
 414 *expressing its conformity or lack of objection to the Deed of Revocation of Donation.*

416 *May I move for the adoption of the committee report, Mr. Chairman.*

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418 The motion to adopt the committee report was approved. Thereafter, a motion was
 419 presented indorsing back the matter to the Office of the City Mayor which was favorably seconded
 420 and approved, to wit:

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RESOLUTION NO. 125 – 2024

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WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an indorsement from the City Mayor, requesting the City Council to pass a resolution of conformity or lack of any objection to the Deed of Revocation of Donation executed by the heirs of Spouses Norberta Dahang and Andres Paular, covering a parcel of land in Barangay Orok, Surigao City;

WHEREAS, per Deed of Revocation of Donation duly notarized by Atty. Sean Clark Labastida, the late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular executed the first donation in favor of the City of Surigao with the condition that it shall be used as a site of Tagbangkaan Primary School of the provincial capital of Surigao, Province of Surigao del Norte, recorded in the notarial register of the late Atty. Pedro C. Navarro sometime in the year 1955;

445 **WHEREAS**, in the same year, the late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular
 446 executed a Deed of Donation conveying one hectare of land, known as Lot No. 2560 situated at
 447 Barangay Orok, Surigao City, to the then Municipality of Surigao, subject to the condition that it be
 448 used as a school site, as documented in the Original Certificate of Title No. RO-232;

449
 450 **WHEREAS**, according to the Deed of Revocation of Donation, the portion subject of the first
 451 donation remains unutilized while the Oroc Elementary School now stands on the land which is the
 452 subject of the second donation;

453
 454 **WHEREAS**, the heirs of the donors revoked the first donation and demanded the immediate
 455 reconveyance of the ownership and possession of the same to them;

456
 457 **WHEREAS**, revocations of Deed of Donations are governed by the New Civil Code, and the
 458 endorsement from the Office of the City Mayor did not attach the two Deeds of Donations, thus
 459 rendering it impossible to confirm whether both donations are subject to conditions stipulating the
 460 use of the lots as school sites or if the donation is absolute in nature;

461
 462 **WHEREAS**, there is no proof establishing the relation of Josephine A. Luna and Josephine
 463 A. Quitarig to the late spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular, making it impossible to verify
 464 whether they are heirs of the donors or the only heirs thereof;

465
 466 **WHEREAS**, the Committee on Urban Development and Land Use recommends that the
 467 Sangguniang Panlungsod refrain, at the moment, from passing a resolution expressing its conformity
 468 or lack of objection to the Deed of Donation;

469
 470 **NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Jose Expeditus B. Bayana, seconded by
 471 Honorable Karl Duane A. Casurra, it was unanimously

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 473 **RESOLVED:** To pass a resolution endorsing back the letter request of Josephine A. Luna
 474 and Jocelyn A. Quitarig, representing the heirs of spouses Noberta Dahang and Andres Paular for
 475 the passage of a resolution by the Sangguniang Panlungsod signifying its Lack of Objection to a
 476 Deed of Revocation of Donation, to the office of the City Mayor, City Planning and Development
 477 Office, and The City Assessor's Office to act on the recommendations of the Committee.

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 479 **RESOLVED FURTHER:** That copies of this resolution be furnished the Honorable City
 480 Mayor, City Planning City Planning and Development Office, and the City Assessor's Office, for their
 481 information.

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 485 Honorable Bayana continued.

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 487 **HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:**

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 489 *Last report, Mr. Chairman is that of the Committee on Appropriations.*

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 491 *Subject: The Ordinances Containing the Annual Budget for CY 2024 of Barangays Luna and*
 492 *Zaragosa.*

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 494 *Facts: Both the annual budgets of Barangays Luna and Zaragosa have been favorably*
 495 *endorsed by the Local Finance Committee, subject to the usual statutory limitations.*

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 497 *Recommendation: The Committee on Appropriations therefore recommends the passage of*
 498 *a resolution approving the ordinances containing the annual budget CY 2024 of Barangays Luna and*
 499 *Zaragosa.*

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 501 *May I move for the adoption of the committee report, Mr. Chairman.*

502 The motion to adopt the committee report was approved. Thereafter, a motion was
503 presented and favorably seconded and approved, to wit:

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506 **RESOLUTION NO. 126 – 2024**

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508 **A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BARANGAY ANNUAL BUDGETS FOR CY**
509 **2024 OF BARANGAYS LUNA AND ZARAGOSA, ALL OF THIS CITY.**

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511 **WHEREAS**, endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod are the Barangay Annual Budgets
512 for CY 2024 of Barangays Luna and Zaragosa, all of this city, for the conduct of a review process;

513
514 **WHEREAS**, the annual budgets of the enumerated barangays were favorably endorsed by
515 the Local Finance Committee subject to the usual statutory limitations provided under the Local
516 Government Code, as well as, other rules;

517
518 **NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Jose Expeditus B. Bayana, seconded by
519 Honorable Karl Duane A. Casurra, it was unanimously

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521 **RESOLVED:** To pass a Resolution Approving the Ordinances containing the Barangay
522 Annual Budgets for CY 2024 of the following barangays, to wit:

Honorable Aldonza was recognized and the **RULES ARE SUSPENDED** to allow the resource persons to join the discussion. Thereafter, he read the full text of the said proposed ordinance.

HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:

CSWD, and then Psychometrician...Psychometrician is under also the CSWD? Ikaw, Ma'am? May we know what is the program of the CSWD, in so far as, mental health of the youth is concerned? We have been...there were several reports before about suicides, and then, it only goes to show how much the importance of looking up after the mental health of the youth. May we know what is the program of the CSWD to address the problem?

MS. BEVERLY ELIZAR/SWA, CSWD:

Good afternoon everyone. Currently, we are coordinating with the City Population in ano sa LCPC, we go to the barangays during the People's Day for mental health awareness. We discuss it together with other programs po.

HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:

Only during People's Day?

MS. ABEGAIL UNGRIA/PSYCHOMETRICIAN, CSWD:

We also have, we currently have hotlines in the social media. We have, for mental health hotlines, we're presenting the different numbers of the social workers from the City Social and Welfare Development Office, so that in times of where youths or anyone who needs mental health advises or sessions, they can contact us directly. And we are also, our office also is open to counselling sessions if anyone calls us or comes in our office po.

HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:

You are, of course, aware that there are areas in the city where no cellular phones signals are available, correct? For example, Arellano District. Would you be amenable if you will include in this ordinance how to address, among the functions of which, is you address the mental health issues?

MS. ABEGAIL UNGRIA/PSYCHOMETRICIAN, CSWD:

Yes po.

HON. JOSE EXPEDITUS B. BAYANA:

Secondly, you said also that there will be teen desks established in each and every barangay, what will be the composition of this?

674 *Good afternoon, Mr. Chair and to everyone, good afternoon. Actually, with regard to the*
 675 *mental health issues na niigo na sa ato city, Surigao City Teens Center is a good venue nga maka-*
 676 *raise ta ug awareness with regard to mental health. And we also include the establishing of Teen*
 677 *Desk in every barangays because sa kanang imo giingon Sir nga naay barangays nga walay signal,*
 678 *so Teen Desk is a good way para makaduol sila directly sa mga barangay para ma-address pud nila*
 679 *kung unsay concern ang atoa mga teens. And the composition of the Teen Desk will be our Barangay*

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686 *But that composition is not contained, is not reflected in the proposed ordinance, correct?*

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688 *Additionally, Honorable Azarcon also asked whether or not the proposed ordinance is*
 689 *patterned from ordinances of other cities in which the resource person answered that the same was*
 690 *an original creation.*

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692 **HON. CACEL R. AZARCON:**

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694 *Next query is, what is our basis in referring teen from between ages 10 to 19 years old?*

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696 **ATTY. JOSHUA LEX ANDREW U. SILVOSA / CITY LEGAL OFFICER:**

698 *Okay. Mr. Chair, for our definition we pattern it under Republic Act 10354 which is the Responsible*
 699 *Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act. However, in this law they mentioned of adolescence as between*
 700 *10 to 19. However, if this body will prefer another definition we also have one from the Family Code of the*
 701 *Philippines Article 336 in which the definition of teen is, are those individuals between 13 and 17, 13 to 17*
 702 *are classify as teenagers. So, Mr. Chairman, it is within, this is our first proposal however if this august body*
 703 *will prefer that definition describe in the Civil Code we are always ready to replace it and change it from 13*
 704 *to 17.*

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706 **HON. CACEL R. AZARCON:**

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708 *In other words, you are not yet sure or as to the ages to be included in the definition of teen.*

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710 **ATTY. JOSHUA LEX ANDREW U. SILVOSA / CITY LEGAL OFFICER:**

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712 *Mr. Chairman, our first proposal are what we wrote here, I submitted to this body is that of the*
 713 *definition within Republic Act 10354, why? Because this is more connected to the purpose of this teen desk,*
 714 *Mr. Chairman, which is more on health and reproductive discussion, Mr. Chairman, that is why we use this*
 715 *definition under Republic Act 10354.*

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717 **HON. CACEL R. AZARCON:**

719 *My next question is, how is this teen desk related to the duties and responsibilities, and functions of*
 720 *the Sangguniang Kabataan?*

722 **ATTY. KRISTEL GRACE C. BUNIEL / YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICER IV:**

724 *Good afternoon to our honorable. Yes, Sir, good afternoon, Sir. Well Sir, according to the mandate*
 725 *of SK, ang SK they also follow the mandate of the National Youth Commission and the National Youth*
 726 *Commission encourages or implements to the SK that they should implement the teen centers of*

727 participation, one of which, health which this is also included, Sir. So basically, under gihapon sija sa SK
728 that they can really tackle and discuss this under their offices.
