**SUBJECT:**

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245 *An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 351, Series of 2012, "An Ordinance Establishing  
246 the Night Market the Surigao City Boulevard, Lopez Jaena Street and Magallanes Street, Providing  
247 Guidelines Thereof and For Other Purposes.*

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**FACTS/FINDINGS:**

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252 *The Committee on Business, Trade, Industry and Economic Enterprise conducted the  
253 second committee hearing regarding the proposed Amendments to Ordinance No. 351, Series of  
254 2012. During the committee hearing, a new draft was presented with proposed changes made to the  
255 Ordinances, as follows:*

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- *The original title of the Ordinance has been revised to include Magallanes Street and Lopez Jaena Street. The new title reads "An Ordinance Establishing the Night Market at the Surigao City Boulevard, Lopez Jaena Street, and Magallanes Street Providing Guidelines Thereof and for other Purposes. "*
- *Addition of a Requirement Under Section 3, Presenting Proof of Residence in Surigao City for at least Six (6) Months.*
- *The existing Ordinance set the night market operating hours in Surigao City Boulevard from 4:00 PM to 12 AM. It has been proposed to change from 7:00 PM to 12:00 AM.*
- *The operating hours for vendors in Lopez Jaena Street and Magallanes Street will start from 5:00 Pm to 10:00 PM.*

270 *There will be strict enforcement of the new operating hours. No Vendors will be permitted to  
271 begin setting up or selling before 7:00 PM in the city Boulevard and before 5:00 PM in Lopez Jaena  
272 Street and Magallanes Street. This enforcement keeps things orderly, prevents traffic jams, and  
273 ensures all vendors can do business fairly.*

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*Mr. Chair, I move for the adoption of my Committee Report.*

The motion to adopt the committee report was approved. The proponent then requested the Secretary to calendar the same for first reading in the next regular session and informed everyone that a public hearing with regard the matter is scheduled on June 7, 2024 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon.

295 *Title No. T- 10856 to the City Government.*

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297 **FACTS:** *The Heirs of Jose B. Cortes, Marcos D. Cortes, Charito Cortes-Gapud, Gloria*  
298 *Cortes-Toralballa, Hernan D. Cortes, and Fanny Cortes, represented by Engr. Inocencio R. Cortes,*  
299 *are the owners of a parcel of land denominated as Lot No. 727 and covered by Transfer Certificate*  
300 *of Title No. 10856 with an area of one hundred sixty-five thousand and forty-eight square meters*  
301 *(165,048 sqm).*

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303 *The aforesaid personalities are willing to donate to the city government a portion of said*  
304 *parcel of land with an area on nine thousand five hundred fifty square meters (9,550 sqm) to be used*  
305 *as a road lot. It is located in Barangay Cagniog and the road would lead to city-owned properties.*

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307 **RECOMMENDATION:** *The Committee on Urban Development and Land Use finds the*  
308 *intention to donate by the would-be donors be highly beneficial to the city government and thereof,*  
309 *is inclined to favorably grant an authority to the City Mayor to accept the donation.*

448 All the portions to be donated will be used as road right of way and are all located for  
449 Barangay Luna, Surigao City.

450  
451 Considering that the donations would not cost the city government a single centavo for their  
452 purchase. It is obvious that the donations would be beneficial to the city government.

453  
454 **RECOMMENDATION:** The Committee on Urban Development and Land Use, therefore,  
455 recommends the grant of an authority to the City Mayor to accept the donations subject to the  
456 presentation of a resolution passed by the Board of Director of I. Cortes Development Corporation
