HON. BALTAZAR C. ABIAN:

Uh, Mr. Chair, uh, herein letter respectfully forwarded to the Chairman, Committee on Transportation, Communication and Utilities, a letter, a request from the Maharlika Transport Service Cooperative. The MATRASECO asking for support from the Local Government Unit of Surigao City.

The committee conducted a committee hearing last August 5 regarding to the matter, and unanimously agreed together, to give access to and use of off-street loading and unloading areas outlined in their route map. The request aligns with their application to the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board for a Certificate of Public Convenience, which includes Modifications, Extension to routes reaching Surigao City Public Terminal.

Mr. Chair, I move for the suspension of the Rules to allow the resource persons from Maharlika Transport Service Cooperative.

The **RULES ARE SUSPENDED** to allow the resource persons to answer queries from the august body.

MR. BONIFACIO R. ARANCES/ CHAIRMAN, MAHARLIKA TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE/ RESOURCE PERSON:

Gusto namin Sir na, kami kasi Sir, nagbiyahi ng Cantilan to Surigao City noon pa. Ngayon, nong nag ano na ng LTFRB, na maging Cooperative, ngayon yong rota namin Sir hanggang Bad-as lang. Ngayon yong mga pasahero naming Cantilan to Surigao ay nagreklamo na gusto nila lalo na yong mga pasyente, pumunta sa Pier, gusto nila na makarating kami sa Surigao at saka pag uwi nila Sir, ang last trip kasi ng Bachelor hanggang ala una lang, ngayon gusto sila makakauwi sila ng kahit anong oras lalo na yong mga pasyente. HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

Oh, LTFRB what is this request as presented to earlier? Uh, they are this Maharlika is issued a franchise, but only to Bad-as and now they wanted to go as far as Surigao City.

MS. ROXAN P. GUPANA/PROJECT DEVELOPMENT OFFICER II/RESOURCE SPEAKER:

Yes. Good afternoon, everyone. I'm Roxan Gupana from LTFRB, uh, Project Development Officer II, under the Modernization Program. Uh, way back to 2019, Mr. Chair, si Maharlika is nag-submit siyag application, but during that time, wala patay units nga, ang iyahang supposedly nga dapat rota ang Cantilan to Surigao. But during that time, wala patay units for many bus, so, gi-align ang ilahang routes nga PUJ taman lang sa Bad-as, kay during ato na time wala pay pwede nga units nga modagan ing-ana kataas almost 100km. So, 2023 Mr. Chair na allow ang mini-bus mao nga si Maharlika nag propose siya og extension of routes from Bad-as, from Cantilan-Bad-as e-proceed na into Surigao City. Uh, we conducted pilot study, survey nga gi-forward pod namo didtoa sa DOTR kay si Region, Mr. Chair walay kapasidad to approve the routes because, e-reroute sya. So, upon sa pag-consult namo didtua sa Central Office gipangayoan si Maharlika og letter of support from the LGU kung asa nag- extend ang route. Kay ang concern sa DOTR is basin og matandog ang inyohang local transport public route plan, which is minimal revision na raba to sya. So, mao nga naa pod mi karon to explain what happened to Maharlika. So, niingon si Maharlika, Mr. Chair nga, if kung Cantilan to Bad-as lang, kung magkuha sila og modern units dili na viable. Tungod kay ang ilahang pasahero mostly gyud from Cantilan to Surigao City gyud kay naa diri ang centro sa komersyo sa Surigao City.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

I would just like to be clarified on this, your request is a letter of support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of each off-street loading and unloading area in the route map. Who are those...are we the property owners or managers? Because we are the local government unit here. I mean, your request is somehow an amendment to your franchise, but your letter support that you would want is a letter support from property owners/managers regarding...I do not understand this...regarding access to, or use of each off-street loading and unloading...What is this, Roxan? What is this request? Can you enlighten us on this?

MS. ROXAN P. GUPANA/PROJECT DEV'T. OFFICER, LTFRB:

Mr. Chair, if I may. In part sa LTFRB Mr. Chair, dili...gina-allow lang si Maharlika sa transport terminal sa Surigao City. So, mao na siya ang amoa. among point...

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

So, when you say, they are applying for the amendment of their franchise? Their franchise?

MS. ROXAN P. GUPANA/PROJECT DEV'T. OFFICER, LTFRB:

Yes Mr. Chair.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

So that, it would appear that because they are applying for an amendment of their franchise, you are seeking, more or less, this is more or less, a no objection resolution that would allow Maharlika to ply the route Cantilan to Surigao City Transport Terminal, and vice versa. That's what you wish to have the support of the local government unit that they'd be able to use the Surigao City Public Market as part of their amended route...the city property is the LGU?

MS. ROXAN P. GUPANA/PROJECT DEV'T. OFFICER, LTFRB:

Yes, Mr. Chair.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

- Proposed Ordinance "An Ordinance Creating City Human Rights Action Center (HRAC) under the office of the City Mayor and Defining Its Power and Functions." (By: Committee on Social Welfare)

Honorable Aldonza was recognized and requested for the **SUSPENSION OF THE RULES** to allow the resource persons to join the discussion. He then proceeded to read the content of the proposed ordinance.

Honorable Catre then asked if it is necessary that the 54 barangays be directed to pass an ordinance creating Barangay Human Rights Action Center considering that the proposed ordinance has already covered the creation of the Action Center on Barangay level.

MR. ROBERT E. PATAYON/CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS OFFICER/DILG:

Okay, I will, I will proceed. Be the way there is a joint Memorandum Circular No. 01-2014. It is already long overdue for all the local government units, we are required to and mandated to create the Local Human Rights Actions Center. And there is a, it is stipulated here in the Section 50 of the Local Government Code Paragraph B and Sub-Paragraph 1 that all local government units in all levels, provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays are mandated to create the human rights committee. So that is why I am sure na dinhi sa ato sa Sangguniang Panlungsod we have already the human rights committee, di ba?

And then they are also required to develop local policies as well as legislations to address all human rights and rule of laws and to access the justice noh? in the grassroot levels. So that is why the Office or the Department of the Interior and Local Government and the Commission on Human Rights design this joint Memorandum Circular to mainstream the human rights through rule of law and access to justice. And part of it is to create barangay human rights actions center aside from the city, provincial city and municipal human rights action center. Since it was agreed during our committee meeting that the BHRAC will be incorporated on the certain Ordinance. So I think the legal officer in their part kay sila man ang nag draft aning kuan Ordinance. So, sija rakan siguroy maka-elaborate ani for more...

HON. NOEL CHRISTIAN G. CATRE JR.:

Is it the ways of a human resources of the government to actually require each and every barangay to again make an Ordinance for the creation of a Barangay Human Rights Action Center? Is this Ordinance not enough? We can simply amend perhaps the first paragraph of Section 6.

After a thorough discussion with regard the redundancy that would arise from the provision of the last paragraph of Section 6, the proponent agreed to delete the last paragraph of Section 6 of the proposed ordinance. Thereafter, a motion was presented to approve the proposed ordinance under second reading with the amendment which was favorably seconded and approved. The Secretary was directed to calendar the same on third and final reading on the next Regular Session.
