 537 process of its release. Consequently, the Presiding Officer and proponent agreed to have the request  
 538 passed.

585 **WHEREAS**, upon thorough deliberation on the matter, the said request has been favorably  
 586 agreed upon;

588 **NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Jose Expeditus B. Bayana, unanimously  
 589 seconded by all the members present, be it;

591 **RESOLVED:** To pass a resolution requesting the Provincial Government of Surigao del
