The subject of this is the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2022 - 085 and the need for a City Ordinance incorporating the said Memorandum.

The Facts and findings, the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2022 - 085, serves as a directive for all Local Government Units to ensure that public roads are cleared of obstructions to promote safety, accessibility and efficient road use. The circular mandates the removal of any hindrances such as electric posts, illegal structures, and improperly parked vehicles emphasizing the LGU's responsibility in overseeing and enforcing the clearing approach. The circular highlights the need for local ordinances to define these obstructions and provide mechanisms for enforcement, including penalties for non-compliance, ensuring smooth road operations across municipalities.

During the committee hearing, a persistent concern was raised regarding electric posts obstructing roads, particularly after road widening projects. These posts owned by the Surigao del Norte Electric Cooperative often remained in place despite the completion of roadworks, creating significant public safety risk and undermining the intended benefits of the infrastructure improvements. The presence of these posts in the middle of roads poses hazards to motorists and pedestrians alike, and delays of their removal slowing down critical infrastructure progress

Under the current arrangement, SURNECO is responsible for relocating the electric post, but several factors have contributed to ongoing delays. These delays are partly due to a perceived lack of urgency on SURNECO's part, as well as the absence of a clear enforcement mechanism to ensure prompt action. The committee highlighted that the City Government is constrained in addressing the issue directly, as it lacks the legal authority to independently remove the post without coordination and cooperation from the concerned agencies, including SURNECO and the DPWH.

The absence of a clear and enforceable ordinance that outlines the specific responsibilities, timelines, and penalties for post relocation, progress on infrastructure projects will continue to be hindered. This not only impacts public safety, but also affects the efficiency of road developments meant to improve mobility within the city. Hence, there is an immediate need for a local ordinance that provides a clear, legal provisions to ensure the removal of all road obstructions as mandated by the circular, ensuring public safety and accessibility.

The recommendation, the Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure, together with the Committee on Utilities strongly recommends the immediate drafting and enactment of a City Ordinance that fully integrates the provisions of the DILG Memorandum, Circular No. 2022 - 085 and its clarifications. This ordinance should serve as the legal foundation to ensure timely and coordinated efforts in removing electric post and other road obstruction thereby improving the safety and efficiency of its public works projects. This legislative action will ensure that all future road developments comply with DILG directives, and the delay caused by legal and procedural drafts are eliminated. In due time, the committee in coordination with the City Legal Office, will draft a proposed ordinance for endorsement to this council for immediate deliberation and approval.
