 Indorsement from the City Mayor, forwarding to the City Council the Barangay Resolution No. 20, series of 2024 of Barangay Nabago, this City, entitled: A Resolution Declaring No Objection to the Establishment and Operationalization of the 24.5 Hectares Surigao City Mariculture Park (SCMP) in the Coastal Waters within the Territorial Jurisdiction of Barangay Nabago, Surigao City, Province of Surigao del Norte.

FACTS/FINDINGS:

 A joint Committee hearing was conducted on December 10, 2024 to discuss the proposed Surigao City Mariculture Park project. During the hearing, Engineer Jose Alfonso Casura, the Officerin-Charge of the City Environment and Natural Resources Office, discussed the steps being taken for the proposed Surigao City Mariculture Park project covering approximately 24.5 hectares within the identified Mariculture zone in Barangay Nabago.

Engineer Casurra informed this representation and the joint Committee that to proceed with the project, the City Government of Surigao must secure various environmental permits, including Environmental Compliance Certificate, (ECC) Protected Areas Management Board (PAMB) Clearance and other related DENR permits.

To comply with these requirements, Mr. Chairman, documents were submitted to the DENR Office in Tubod for evaluation. During the review process, the DENR requested a Barangay Resolution stating no objection to the project. Barangay Nabago then issued Barangay Resolution No. 20, series 2024, last July, which interposes no objection to the Mariculture Park project. However, due to the procedural delays from the Barangay to the City Legal Office and finally to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the resolution has only now reached the Council for the adoption.

RECOMMENDATION:

After careful deliberation with no further objection raised during the Committee hearing of the Committee on Agriculture and Fisheries and the Committee on Environmental and Natural Resources, chaired by Hon. No, no. We, you go first with the Supplemental Budget No. 04. So, I'll take over. Attorney Galido. What is this Supplemental Budget No. 04? All about in the amount of Twenty-Seven Million, Eight Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand, Ninety-Seven Pesos and Sixty-Four Centavos. (\$\mathbb{P}\$27,876,097. 64)

ATTY. JEFFREY P. GALIDO/CITY BUDGET OFFICCER:

Good morning, Mr. Chair and to the more handsome members of this August body. The Supplemental Budget touches on the additional wages to be given to our job orders, contractual employees or contract of service employees, and other expenses which we taken out from our savings from PS and 20...Ano, I mean capital outlays for the current year 2024. And also the 30% part of the LDRR for 2018 which is convertible now to the general fund after five (5) years.

HON, ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

So you are saying that this Supplemental Budget No. 04 are the savings that will be utilized to pay for our benefits?

ATTY. JEFFREY P. GALIDO/CITY BUDGET OFFICCER:

Yes, Mr. Chair.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

Is there anyone who would wish to ask questions regarding this Supplemental Budget which will be the basis for the grant of the year-end benefits? If none, then we'll just have a lumpsum discussion. We'll go first to the resolution recommending for the grant of the year-end cash incentive. How much is this year's cash incentive? Who will discuss that?

ATTY. JEFFREY P. GALIDO/CITY BUDGET OFFICCER:

With regards to the CNA, for the CNA this is a collective negotiation agreement for regular employees. The Local Finance Committee recommends not more than Thirty Thousand (30,000.00) as benefit to be given to regular employees. However, this is the maximum amount as same also with the last year although the amount given last year was only 25 because there was SRI. And this year, we are not sure about the SRI yet because we have not yet received the guidelines as to the amount. But the guidelines would be almost the same with the last year.

It was also mentioned that the additional wages for the Job Order Employees would be 13,000.00 which is 1,000.00 higher than last year. However, Honorable Abian proposed for an amendment on the qualifications of Job Order Employees in order to receive the additional wages. The proposed amendment are as follows:

MR. JEFFREY GALIDO/BUDGET OFFICER:

Okay. May I clarify, Mr. Chair, so that everybody...okay, same with the past few years that we are implementing for an employee to be entitled to this additional wage, he has to accumulate at least 6 months and he has to be employed in the city as of December 15, 2024. Because that would be the basis why we are giving them additional wages, because if we will not put that qualification, then we don't have basis for granting additional wages. We are not allowed to grant bonus for Job Orders, we are not allowed by that. So, to give benefit to our Job Order, we have to revise the guidelines without circumventing the law. That's why accumulation of 6 months and he has to be employed in the city as of December 15. The cut-off for the accumulation of 6 months must be October 31. So, January 2 to October 31, he has to serve 6 months, then additional qualification that of he has to be with City Hall as of December 15. Now, if he has served 6 months and he is not employed, then we are really sorry to inform that he is not qualified for additional wages.

So, pag 4 months ra sab as of October 31 and he is also employed as of December 15, then he is entitled for a pro-rata of this 13,000. This is the same guidelines that we are using for almost 5 years already, I think, since the granting of the additional wages.

There being no more discussion and the proposed amendment being amenable to the proponent, the resource persons were excused and the **RULES WERE REINSTATED**.

Who will handle? We are now to present to the members of this council of what transpired yesterday in the public hearing and we will present to you the salient features of the draft zoning

ordinance which basically is upgrading of the zoning that we had before 2022. The ones that we will be treating will cover 2023-2032. So, 2023 we are already 2024, so there is really a need for us to fast track the approval of this.

Anyway, this ordinance was approved will still be under the review by the DHSUD and Provincial Land Use Committee, so our strategy here is just to pass it in the manner that we can have it approved for this year and then subject to review by the DHSUD.

HON. JOSHUA EMILIO S. GELI:

Mr. Chairman, I have something to add also.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

Councilor Geli.

HON.JOSHUA EMILIO S. GELI:

Just to share to everyone. In compliance with the Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code, LGU's are required to prepare Comprehensive Land Use Plans and implement zoning ordinances that align with the national, regional frameworks. The CLUP processes includes 12 steps with public hearing is being the 9th step.

For the information of everyone on December 11, 2024 the Sangguniang Panlungsod conducted a public hearing for the draft zoning of Surigao City. The hearing presided by Vice Mayor Alfonso S. Casurra took placed at the City Cultural Center and gathered 160 attendees representing various sectors, including barangay LGU's, the public sector, major lot owners, and Civil Society Organizations and our city offices.

The CPDO presented the proposed land uses and zoning regulations focusing on the five urban barangays namely: Washington, Taft, Luna, Canlanipa and San Juan as well as the growth areas of some urban barangays namely: Bonifacio, Sabang, Rizal and Cagniog and of course, the rural island and mainland barangays. During the hearing participants raised concerns and provided feedback on the proposed zoning ordinance, zoning regulations which were duly noted by the CLUP Technical Working Group. At the conclusion of the meeting there were no objections to approve zoning ordinance with participants expressing their support.

So with that, Mr. Chairman, let us open the floor for the presentation for our CLUP Technical Working Group.

RULES WERE SUSPENDED.

HON. ALFONSO S. CASURRA/PRESIDING OFFICER:

May we know who will be the one to present? We will be presenting Barangay Taft, Barangay Washington, Barangay Luna, Barangay Canlanipa and Barangay Rizal, San Juan and Sabang in that order because the rest barangays are not affected and will just go straight to Washington. Go ahead. What are the salient features in the new proposed zoning in Barangay Washington?

Mr. Gorgonio proceeded to present the different zones and/or amendments reflected in each barangays and discussed the salient features of the proposed ordinance as presented during the public hearing.

After the comprehensive presentation and there being no more discussions, the resource persons were excused and **RULES WERE REINSTATED**.

Thereafter Honorable Geli presented a motion to approve the matter under second reading, which was favorably seconded and approved. He then requested for the SUSPENSION OF THE **RULES** to approve the same under third and final reading. On motion of Honorable Joshua Emilio S. Geli, seconded by Honorable Joseph Joey S.
