FACTS/FINDINGS:

429

430

The joint Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure and Agriculture and Fisheries
 431 conducted a hearing last April 29, 2024 to discuss the request of the City Mayor denominated as
 432 URGENT asking for a resolution to authorize him to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding
 433 with the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) for the construction of the Surigao City
 434 Fish Port at Barangay Washington, Surigao City. The proposed Memorandum of Understanding
 435 (MOU) between the Local Government Unit of Surigao and PFDA represents the initial steps
 436 towards establishing a mutually beneficial collaboration for the construction and operation of the
 437 fish port. The Surigao City Fish Port Project aims to address the growing demands and challenges
 438 in the fisheries sector, particularly in Surigao City and its neighboring areas in Caraga Region.

439

440

During the joint committee hearing, it was noted that there is already significant progress in
 441 processing the documentary requirements from the different offices and other agencies involved in
 442 the project, with the understanding that the documentary requirements needed by the Philippine
 443 Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) will be filed and processed even before the signing of the
 444 Memorandum of Understanding. This shows that all parties involved are firmly committed to
 445 making sure the project will push through. In addition, the favorable discussions and support
 446 indicated a shared commitment to see this initiative move forward. The amount of 100 Million
 447 pesos is now available under the 2024 General Appropriations Act to fund Phase 1 of the Project.

The committee has thoroughly reviewed the proposed Memorandum of
 452 Understanding with the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to build the Surigao
 453 City Fish Port. We strongly recommend authorizing the Honorable City Mayor Pablo Yves L.
 454 Dumlao II, to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding with the Philippine Fisheries
 455 Development Authority for the construction of the Surigao City Fish Port, moving forward with this
 456 partnership due to its clear benefits to our city.

523 **FACTS/FINDINGS:**

524

525 During the hearing to address the request of the Honorable City Mayor, Engr. Joal
526 Casurra of the City Enro explained that "the proposed Mariculture project will cover a total area of
527 24.5 hectares and that a portion of the proposed area falls within the DENR identified Surigao City-
528 Taganaan-Placer Protected Landscape and Seascape area" thus the need for an authority to apply
529 for a PAMB clearance, Environmental Compliance Certificate, and Special Agreement on Protected
