The Surigao City Fish Port Project aims to address the growing demands and challenges in the fisheries sector, particularly in Surigao City and its neighboring areas in Caraga Region.

 During the joint committee hearing, it was noted that there is already significant progress in processing the documentary requirements from the different offices and other agencies involved in the project, with the understanding that the documentary requirements needed by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) will be filed and processed even before the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding. This shows that all parties involved are firmly committed to making sure the project will push through. In addition, the favorable discussions and support indicated a shared commitment to see this initiative move forward. The amount of 100 Million pesos is now available under the 2024 General Appropriations Act to fund Phase 1 of the Project.

RECOMMENDATION:

The committee has thoroughly reviewed the proposed Memorandum of Understanding with the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to build the Surigao City Fish Port. We strongly recommend authorizing the Honorable City Mayor Pablo Yves L. Dumlao II, to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding with the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority for the construction of the Surigao City Fish Port, moving forward with this partnership due to its clear benefits to our city.

Joal Casurra of the City Enro explained that "the proposed Mariculture project will cover a total area of 24.5 hectares and that a portion of the proposed area falls within the DENR identified Surigao City-Taganaan-Placer Protected Landscape and Seascape area" thus the need for an authority to apply for a PAMB clearance, Environmental Compliance Certificate, and Special Agreement on Protected Area from the Department of Environment and Natural Recourses.

RECOMMENDATION:

The committee hereby recommends the passage of a resolution granting the Honorable City Mayor the authority to apply for a Protected Area Management Board Clearance, Environmental Compliance Certificate, and Special Agreement on Protected Area from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.
